MSGNA POSTER CONTEST

MSGNA 2013 Fall Conference

The poster contest will take place at the Fall Educational Course. The prize may be awarded for 1st Place. The following criteria must be met or the poster will be disqualified:

- MSGNA members in good standing for 1 year prior to display date are eligible to participate, current officers and board members excluded.
- The poster shall have a Research, Educational, or Clinical theme and must be related to the field of Gastroenterology.
- Posters shall be submitted on a minimum 2' x 4' up to 4' x 8' background.
- A poster abstract (limit of 250 words) must be made to the MSGNA President Elect by August 1, 2013.

Judging takes place at the MSGNA Fall Educational Course by three members of MSGNA who are not on the Board of Directors. In the event of a tie, the President-elect will select one other impartial person to act as a tie breaker.

Judging is based on the following criteria:

- Visual appeal, neatness, creativity of presentation, relatedness to GI field, complexity of subject, completeness of research, originality, and conciseness.
- There are 50 possible points awarded (see adjoining page, "poster evaluation point system")
- Posters must have been awarded a minimum of 30 points to be considered to represent MSGNA at the SGNA Annual Course.

The names of entrants will be included on the back of the exhibit only and shall be kept anonymous until the announcement of winners is made.

The winner will be expected to do the following:

- Send their abstract to SGNA by the due date.
- Transport, set-up and breakdown the poster at the SGNA Annual Course.
- Enlarge the poster to a 4 x 8 foot display.
- Present the treasurer with the letter of acceptance from SGNA to receive the award to attend the Annual Course.
- Attend the SGNA Annual Course. In the event the winner is unable to attend, the monies must be returned to the MSGNA via the current treasurer within 30 days of the SGNA Annual Course.

Monetary awards listed below will be based on the availability of funds:

- Early Bird Registration
- Airfare/Transportation
- Four nights lodging
- Food allowance- \$30.00 a day for up to five days
- 50% of the poster production and shipping costs

Receipts for the above must be submitted to the treasurer within 14 days to receive reimbursement.

If there is more than one author the award will be divided amongst the authors of the winning poster.

Award benefits are subject to change without notice.
